

UNEMPLOYMENT Resource Sheet

At Time of UNEMPLOYMENT

1. Apply for unemployment **IMMEDIATELY**:
 - Phone: 1-800-978-7887 OR
 - Internet Initial Claims: <http://www.ucclaim.wi.org> OR
 - If NO internet connection: go to 3620 Wilgus Avenue, Sheboygan (west of movie theater).

2. Call on all loans **IMMEDIATELY**: Make arrangements to change payment schedule or amounts:
 - Car—ask to skip or reduce payments
 - Home (It is called forbearance.)
 - School
 - Credit Cards

(Experience indicates that though you have called and changed terms, you may still get calls from the collection department.)

3. If you have children in college, call the Financial Aid Office and change FAFSA.

4. Start work on your resume. Try to post resume on line at <http://www.wisconsinjobcenter.org> as soon as possible. Employers can access your resume on line from this site.
