We have included information about the parish Scrip program in this Thursday Folder. If you want your child to bring home your Scrip order, there is a wavier that must be filled out. We will put a current Scrip order form in the first Thursday Folder of each month.

Attendance: According to Archdiocesan policy, attendance days are counted in ½ days. If your child misses 1 full day of school, it counts as 2 absences. They must be in the building when the 8 am bell rings, or they will be counted tardy (unless we know they are at band). If your student comes to school between 8 – 9 am they are marked tardy. If they come in any time after 9 am,

they are marked for 1 absence. Any time your child is gone during the day for a 2 hour absence, they are given 1 absence.

If your child leaves during the day for any reason, they need to sign out (or parents can sign them out).

If your child is going home a way that is different for them, please send us a note so we know how your child is getting home. We are required to keep these notes in our file during the year. It also helps to cut down on the last minute phone calls home with questions.
